On the heels of the City-wide plastic bag ban, LMB's eco-community project hopes to bring greater awareness to the:

- ◆ Harmful effects of plastic bottle waste to our oceans, landfills, and sea life
- ◆ Misunderstanding that tap water is less pure than most bottled water
- ◆ Potential chemical toxicity leached from disposable plastic bottles
- ◆ Carbon footprint associated with the billions of barrels of oil needed to manufacture and transport bottled water to market per year

These splashy, filtered "H2.0 Stations" boast bottle-refilling dispensers, drinking spouts, and in certain locations, pet-fountains for our four-legged family members!
